MONTHLY PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS

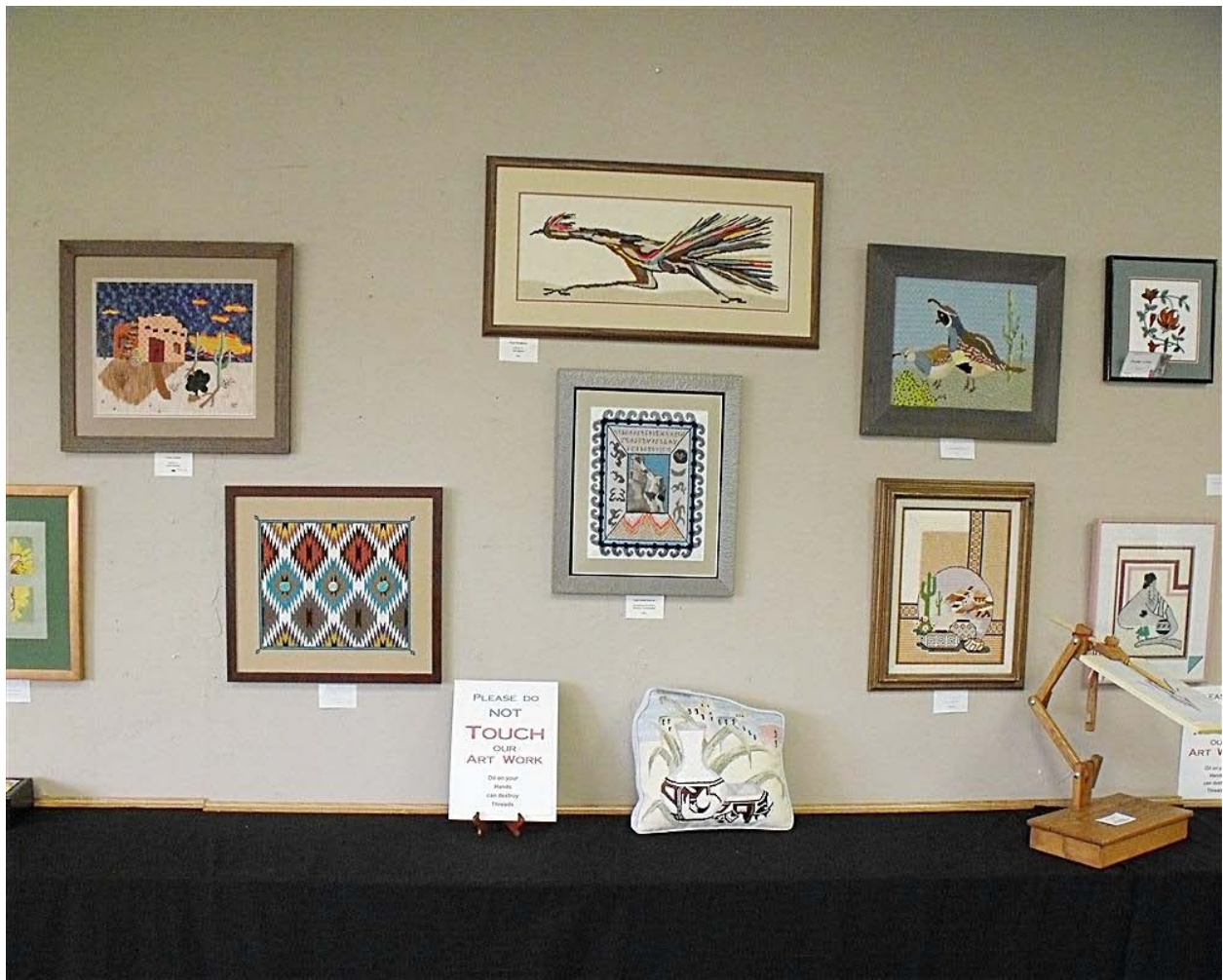
April - Sharon Crescent of Crescent Colours will be our speaker.
