MONTHLY PROGRAMS AND FUTRUE PROJECTS

February Program:

Southwest Beading Appliqué Part III by Mary Ellen Searcy. This will be a stitching day and the day will be “almost full”. Please plan to stay the whole day. Also, please bring your lunch. You will transfer the design, outline the design, break up the design into sections if desired, then pick simple stitches, attach the beaded circle and begin stitching.



SPECIAL NOTE: For those who were not here when Mary Ellen taught the beaded portion of the shaman or bear, but are interested in the stitched portion of the design, you are invited and encouraged to attend. Mary Ellen assures me that she can accommodate you. There would be a \$5.00 charge for the directions. SUPPLIES TO BRING:

In addition to the materials needed for the beaded piece, Mary Ellen suggests the following supplies:

1. Canvas, Congress or #18; no smaller than 9” X 10” for the bear and 9” X 12” for the shaman.
2. Stretcher bars
3. Threads in your choice of colors; suggested are floss (overdyed is fine), Splendor, Fiesta, Kreinik braids and blending filaments, and any other you might wish to use. Include strippable
4. Needles for your canvas/thread size
5. Threader for stitching threads, if needed
6. Sewing thread or floss in a contrasting color for basting
7. Feathers if desired
8. A light if desired
9. A stitching book of stitches
