JANUARY 13 – SPECIAL, SPECIAL!!!!
Artist Waly Young will give a program on painting canvas. He creates

templates when he paints canvases for Brenda Hart. He is a talented stitcher so he knows what we need from the canvas painter. Don't miss this rare insight into the work of the canvas painter.

FEBRUARY 10 – Rosemary Johannesson will give instruction on creating a starfish, and time allowing, a scallop shell.

Bring the following:
6 x 6-inch (or 6 x 12-inch, if you want to sew both) 18 count canvas mounted on stretcher bars

a. The starfish:

#5 perle cotton, color: 950

b. The scallop shell:

#3 perle cotton, white

DMC floss: 353, 407, 543, 778, 927, 928, 3072 and 3743

Bring your regular stitching supplies. Rosemary will supply the other materials
