LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

I would like to pass on an experience that I had over the weekend. You all need to learn something that I learned on Friday. I had been to the pool that morning and had a good work out - in fact, maybe more than ever before. I came home, and in the afternoon, I started getting mild pains in my chest; I thought I had perhaps pulled a muscle. By 7:00 that evening, the pain was harder, and I phoned 911.

My EKG was good, but it was decided a trip to the hospital was warranted. On the following day, Saturday, I had a stent put in and I came home on Sunday afternoon.

My doctor told me that I had a very typical heart problem for a female. "You are a text book example for a woman. Women will have pains when under physical stress such as walking or moving about. Men will have pains even while sitting." I want all of you to be aware of this easy diagnosis!

I also have another artery partially filled so I will have to back for another few days in the hospital. The hospital food was "god-awful", but the care I received was excellent!!
